Zoning and SEO Report: Chris Bower issued a couple of permits

Mt. Pleasant Sewer: Smoke testing done on both plants. A few issues, nothing major. Erika Burkhart will review and send letters to property owners for repairs and modifications needed. Plant working well.

Woods Edge Sewer: see above

Roadmaster: Calvin Fox reported they worked various items for the police dept, repairing broken mowing tractor, and cleaned Stoneybrook Creek. Will be tar and chipping next week.

Old Business:

SOLAR ORDINANCE: John Long made a motion to accept the Solar Ordinance 2022-2. Dan Fetterman seconded. Motion approved.

New Business:

SEWER CONNECTION PROHIBITION: By mandate presented in the form of a letter from DEP, the Township must prohibit any and all new sewer connections to the Mount Pleasant Sewer plant due to a hydraulic and organic overload 3 times

in 3 years discovered through the Chapter 94 report. It is believed a malfunctioning flow meter is the cause and the plant is not actually overloaded. The letter calls for a corrective action report that will be written to explain the prohibition and the intention to submit the 537 amendment and ultimately construct a new facility. The prohibition will be in effect until the new WWTP is functional. John Long made a motion to prohibit any new sewer connections to the Mount Pleasant WWTP. Dan Fetterman seconded. Motion approved.
