Call to Order:

The meeting of the Orange Township Supervisors was called to order via teleconference at 7:30 pm by Calvin Fox. Attending were, Supervisor John Long, Secretary/Treasurer Erika Burkhart, Supervisor Gene "Dan" Fetterman, John and Jennifer Thackray, Don Bogert.

Bills: Supervisor John Long made a motion to approve the paid the bills. Dan Fetterman seconded. Motion approved.

Police Report:

Zoning and SEO Report: Erika Burkhart reported she spoke with Chris Bower and he is taking care of the Flook swimming pool fence problem. Flooks have agreed to install temporary fencing until they decide if they are going to pursue a variance to seek approval to eliminate their need for a fence or they would install a permanent fence.

Mt. Pleasant Sewer: Erika Burkhart spoke with John Bauer and he said everything was running fine.

Woods Edge Sewer: Erika Burkhart spoke with John Bauer and he said everything was running fine. They will be repairing the hole in the pipe soon.

Roadmaster: Calvin Fox reported approval on the grant to complete the work on Buck Road, finished mowing, completed the repairs on Longview Drive, the paving of the Township will be completed after Labor Day. The Township issued an extension to Suit-Kote for the tar and chipping for 2020 due to the fact Suit-Kote was not informed they had won the bid in a timely fashion and will have to rework their schedule. The extension was 15 days.

Old Business:

MOUNT PLEASANT SEWER STUDY: Erika Burkhart explained Erin Threet, HRG, will keep the same pricing that was given in the 2018 proposal. In light of this information, she gave HRG approval to go ahead with the 537 Plan study. Erin Threet expects the study to be completed December or January 2021.

EXCESS ROAD MAINTENANCE/WILLIAMS: The solicitor is still reviewing. The Board tabled any decisions at this time.

PMRS PLAN CHANGES: John Long made a motion to accept the IRS requirement of 4.5% Township contribution to retirement and the cliff vesting term of 10 years. Dan Fetterman seconded. Motion approved.

New Business:

JLB SYSTEMS: John Bauer submitted a letter of intent to retire in January 2021. He has a replacement in place, Alec Engleman.

For the Good of the Township:

The Township is still looking to hire a part-time employee.

Calvin Fox mentioned he texted the food bank representatives to ask them not to park in front of the building so as not to block any entrances.

Adjournment: With no further business left to discuss, Supervisor John Long made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Supervisor Dan Fetterman seconded, motion approved. The meeting was adjourned at 8:15 pm.
