Call to Order:

The meeting of the Orange Township Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 pm by Calvin Fox. Attending via teleconference were, Supervisor John Long, Secretary/Treasurer Erika Burkhart, Supervisor Gene "Dan" Fetterman, John and Jennifer Thackray, Certified Sewer Plant Operator Alec Engleman.

Minutes: The minutes of the January 4, 2021 meeting was presented and approved.

Recognition of Guests: No comments

Mt. Pleasant Sewer: Alec Engleman explained they used an obsolete compressor from the Woods Edge plant to replace a broken one at Mount Pleasant. He explained the plant was running ok.

Woods Edge Sewer: Mr. Engleman explained Roto-Rooter has been working on the tank replacement. Upon inspection of the chlorine contact tank by Mr. Engleman and Jeff Bauer, it was discovered Roto-Rooter placed the dechlorination tank was placed in the wrong baffle of the tank. Mr. Engleman contacted Roto-Rooter and they planned to come back to reset the tank. It was noted that Roto-Rooter had been sent the design plans at the time of bidding the project. The plans showed where the dechlor tank should be placed. Erika Burkhart stated she would re-send the plans so they could review the plans again before performing the modification. It was also noted, Roto-Rooter had met with John Bauer at the plant twice ahead of the start of the job and Mr. Bauer explained the details.

The majority of the project will be funded with a grant from the County's Dirt and Gravel Road program. John Long made a motion to advertise Buck Road phase 2. Dan Fetterman seconded. Motion approved.
